



Menin Gate, Ypres, Belgium

Menin Gate Memorial to the Missing is a war memorial in Ypres, Belgium, dedicated to the British and Commonwealth soldiers who were killed in the Ypres Salient of World War I and whose graves are unknown. Menin Gate, bears the names of more than **54,000** soldiers who died before 16 August 1917 and have no known grave.

Every evening at 8pm precisely, the "Last Post" has been sounded since 1928 under the imposing arches of the Menin Gate. This is where TC v TC players will lay the peace poppy football to commemorate the soldiers of the then British empire who went missing in action.

What is it?

THIS COUNTRY v THAT COUNTRY is a charity football match being played on 28th March 2020. The challenge is to play two halves of football in two different countries on the same day: the first half will be played at the Market Road pitches in north London, with the second half taking place on the Peace Pitch at Flanders, Belgium. The objective is to raise money for young people to participate in the **2020 GLOBAL PEACE GAMES**. Held annually at the Peace Village, Mesen, Belgium, the Global Peace Games is a week-long peace education programme in which around 60 underprivileged children from different backgrounds across the world get together to take part in an inclusive series of activities and sports. The GPGs celebrates the International Day of Peace through sport and has a lasting impact on each and every young person who attends, helping to develop confidence, break down barriers and creates peace makers for the future. The event will poignantly see a Peace Poppy Football going from London to Flanders, before being laid at the Menin Gate in Ypres, Belgium in a declaration of peace.
