



Peace Fields Project: Introduction by Project Director

Students from the hub schools will be introduced to the Peace Fields Project (PFP). They will learn how the project works, why it is important to commemorate the First World War and celebrate peace. The introduction will help students contextualise their PFP work which will be added to their project research. They will learn how to use the Football & Peace website, prepare their project work and visit their local museums to find out more about the First World War in their community and abroad. Students will be given information regarding their trips to Maidstone Museum and University of Kent. They will also be informed about producing an exhibition of their project work and the role sport will play at their Peace Field twinning ceremony event. They will be asked to design and produce a programme for the events day. Students will be invited to take part in documenting their projects on film. Completed PFP Image Consent Forms will be collected at the end of the workshop.
