2025 PEACE FIELD PROJECT'S GLOBAL PEACE GAMES

Children from the USA and Belgium will be participating at the 2025 GPGs, 15th to 21st September 2025, at the Peace Village, Mesen, Belgium, site of the First World War Christmas Truces.

Funded by The Children's Football Alliance

The event celebrates the United Nations' <u>INTERNATIONAL DAY OF PEACE</u>. The GPGs bring young people together from <u>Peace Field Projects</u> (PFP) across the world with the aim of creating peacemakers of the future. Hobe Sound Soccer Club will represent United States of America at the week-long peace education games at The Peace Village. Site of the 1914, First World War Christmas truces.

There are currently <u>80 Peace Pitches in 6 continents</u> twinned with the Peace Pitch, Flanders Peace Field, where German and Allied soldiers stepped out of their trenches Christmas Eve 1914 and momentarily escaped the horrors of war to exchange gifts and play football.

Participants will visit significant battle sites and take part in international games and forums, debating the role of sport at home, in the community, and at war.
