

Me, Myself and I

Introducing activity participants, Peace Field Programme's Global Peace Games

Purpose:

- participants can present themselves in an original way
- participants can express elements of their identity
- participants get to know each other's names
- participants get to know a part of each other's identity (religion, roots, hobby, ...)

Setting:

- Staff give instructions to participants to make a name badge and encourage them to put some of their personality in the badge.
- We provide different materials (see below) and challenge the participants to make an original name badge that they will wear the rest of the day.
- We provide some examples. Staff members make an original name badge for themselves.
- Participants have some time (up to 10 minutes) to make their badge. We don't force them to be original; if they just want to write their name, it's ok.
- Participants wear them for the rest of the first day and hand them in at the end of the day. Participants collect the name badge on the last day of Global Peace Games and write a message about their experience on the back of their badge before handing it back to the staff and leaving for home.

Materials:

- colored pencils,
- emoji stickers
- markers in different colours
- name badges
- paper and scissors.
