Actually, I just want to lay my focus on just one favourite memory, which I can't forget in a hurry.

That favourite memory of mine was when I was given the honour and privilege to be part of those who were selected to lay the footballs in blessed memories of the fallen soldiers who fought and lost their lives in the world war. This was indeed a historical day to have been not only one of the two girls who were selected but also an African girl. It was a great and amazing experience.
